Providence has job opportunities on-campus, especially for students with financial needs. These jobs are similar to Federal Work Study jobs, but our students are hired as part-time employees of the college. The college employment is available to full-time, residential students. Students are the California Minimum Wage. Students are expected to work no less than 4 hours a week and no more than 20 hours a week. Students are eligible for on-campus employment after fulfilling the following requirements:

1. Complete an IAA form and job application
2. Complete an interview and orientation
3. Demonstrate an ability to maintain the academic workload (freshmen will be placed on probation until mid-semester)
